Behaviors that lead to administrative determination will result in each an in school or out of school suspension. Administration reserves the right to modify the consequence based on the behavior.

-Out of School Suspension for Elementary students can be up to 10 days. Students who are on an Individual Education Plan through Special Education Services must have a Manifestation of the Individual Education Plan meeting before the tenth day of total suspensions for a given school year.

-In School and Out of School Suspension do become part of a child's permanent record.
